## An Applet for Managing Chapter Format Information

This program enables the user to insert and automatically update publication-wide the following items:

- Publication Name
- Publication Version
- Chapter Titles
- Chapter Versions
- Chapter Page Counts

With the exception of page counts, each of these can be freely edited within the applet.

Added functionality is also present for matching a publication's internal chapter names with the published ones and vice versa, equating all chapter versions with the first, adding publication name and version variables when they are not already present, and quick-customization features for the publication name entry.

### **Some Important Notes:**

> As of V0.2 of Olde Chap, there is no undo button. Practice safe publishing. Always use a save (as) button before updating a publication with Olde Chap.

> If either standard publication name (PubNameMrkr) or standard version name (PubVersMrkr) are absent, Olde Chap will give the user the option of adding these to the publication. If the user exercises that option, the effect is immediate, i.e. the publication receives the new variable whether or not the Update button is pressed.

The user has the option to choose non-default publication variables for update if they are already available in the publication.

> To insert publication or chapter variables into the text, the user must set the cursor at the desired insertion point before running the script. If the script is started without an insertion point selected, insertion options will be greyed out in the applet.

> In the interest of efficiency, users should consider inserting the variables and/or markers provided by this applet into pages on the page tag view. While this is not a requirement, it is the conceptual usage model around which the applet was designed.

> For those interested in the chapter markers, the applet inserts these markers as invisible text in the following forms:

- Chapter Title:           <\$!CTS><\$!CTE>
- Chapter Version:       <\$!VNS><\$!VNE>
- Chapter Page Count: <\$!PCS><\$!PCE>

Text following the first invisible text marker and before the next instance of **any** invisible text is updated by the applet. Thus, the content of the second text marker is of less importance to the applet than the second marker's presence.

> The text of a Chapter Title or Version as reported in Olde Chap is based on the first occurrence of the corresponding marker within the chapter. If no corresponding marker exists within the chapter, "<none>" will appear in the respective chapter field in the applet. A blank field indicates that the marker is present but no text follows the marker and the next instance of invisible text.
